Measles

There is a measles outbreak in Liverpool affecting unvaccinated children. Measles is highly infectious. It can cause serious illness and can sometimes be fatal. Vaccination with 2 doses of MMR is the only way to protect children and young people.

Contact your GP practice if your child needs an MMR vaccine. The vaccine is free. If you are not sure if your child needs an MMR vaccine, you can contact the GP to ask.

Measles is not just a little kid's problem. Teenagers, young adults and anyone who has missed their MMR vaccination can get measles.

The first signs of measles are:

Fever

Cough, runny nose and red sore eyes

After a few days, a spotty rash appears. It starts on the face and neck and spreads to the rest of the body.
