We have had several incidents of head lice in school. Head lice is a normal part of childhood and

school life - in the UK around 8% of primary school children have head lice at any one time.

We can fight the spread of head lice but we need to work together. If you find head lice on your child's hair, then please inform school. You can get expert advice about diagnosis and treatment by looking at the 'Once a Week, Take a Peek' website which is www.onceaweektakeapeek.com.

One of the simplest ways to deter head lice is to tie your child's hair back with a bobble or slide. Please note that if your child is found to have 'live' lice they are removed from the classroom and we ask you to take them home to be treated immediately.
