Book Swap




Inspired by our Lent theme this term, of being a 'Planet Protector'

Wrap Around Care

The Governors at St Berteline's have been looking at the option

of running a 'Wrap around Childcare Programme' at school. This aim coincides with the governments ambition, that by 2026 all parents and carers of primary school aged-children who need it, will be able to access term time child care in their local area. This programme is designed to support the initial set up of wraparound provision where there is a clear demand. This would need to be selfsustaining and therefore, to establish if this is the case, there is a link below for parents to complete a short survey which should only take a few moments.
