Salt Sunday at Lion Salt Works

On Sunday 13th May from 12.30pm - 4.30pm the Lion Salt Works are holding a Salt Sunday. It's a great mix of Messy Science and Interactive Storytelling for young people coupled with a range of 15 minute Taster Talks aimed at adults which will include the Principal Engineer for Cammell Laird on building the Sir David Attenborough Antarctic survey ship and 'Living with Cancer: Professional and Pastoral Experiences' from a cancer specialist and priest. The afternoon is finished with a short Worship Service with a talk by the Bishop of Birkenhead, Keith Sinclair. Last year the event was really fun with loads of children with their parents having a wonderful time at this multi-award winning museum. The event is free.

Threadworms

Threadworms are the most common worm parasite in children in the UK, affecting up to half of all under 10s. The risk of other family members getting them from an infected child is as high as 75%.

Threadworm eggs can get stuck under fingernails and can be transferred to the mouth or onto surfaces and clothes. If other people touch an infected surface, they can then transfer the eggs to their mouths.

They are passed on by poor hygiene, not washing your hands after going to the toilet or coming into contact with objects contaminated by worm eggs.

Could we please ask all parents to remind their children to wash their hands regularly, especially after going to the toilet.
