Home - School Agreement

Together we will

- ◆ support the child and help achieve a complete education within a Christian environment of faith and love.
- ◆ encourage the children to be an active and responsible member of the school
- ◆ address any special needs which may be required to enable the child to succeed happily in their learning.

As a school family we will try to

- ◆ make sure our child is punctual (but not before 8.45 am), attends school regularly and notify school as early as possible on the day of absence.
- ◆ read and support the school's policies on discipline, bullying, uniform, mobile phone, tablet and camera use, jewellery and medicines and advise the school on any health or relevant family problems. Also read the school's Privacy Notice.
- ◆ attend Open Evenings as appropriate.
- ◆ read with our child on a daily basis and support the school's homework policy.
- ◆ adhere to the policy relating to Promoting Acceptable Adult Visitor Behaviour on School Premises (including parents).
- ◆ limit the amount of screen time our child is exposed to at home. We will not allow our child to access inappropriate social networking sites eg Facebook. Nor will we use social networking platforms in any defamatory way which would bring the school into disrepute.

As a school we will

- ◆ provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of your child.
- ◆ provide a safe and happy environment with help and encouragement to ensure that your child does the best they can. We will teach the children about e-Safety.
- ◆ be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life and worship of the school.
- ◆ provide regular information about school events and your child's progress.
- ◆ ensure that appropriate medical intervention is provided should it be deemed necessary by the teacher. Such intervention may include eye tests, hearing tests or hair checks etc. Parents will always be kept informed of any outcomes.
- ◆ Have due regard to the Equality Act 2010 and value all individuals equally regardless of any differences.

As a pupil at St Berteline's I will

- ◆ treat others as I would like to be treated yourself.
- ◆ be safe around the school.
- ◆ listen and follow directions.
- ◆ look after my own and other people's property.
- ◆ always look for the best in others.
- ◆ agree to follow the rules relating to e-Safety and the use of mobile phones, tablets and cameras.

In order to help the school run smoothly and also to save time and paper, permission is asked of parents and guardians regarding the following issues.
