The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection and Local Authority Risk assessment
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'group' test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days
- Communicate between home and school via various communication means
- Provide free school meals for all of Reception and KS1 as well as those eligible under the benefit criteria

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible via telephone
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will get them tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible via telephone
- If my child is absent from school for any reason, I will contact school immediately
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the social distancing rules
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child and drop off at the appropriate entrance. I will not engage in lengthy conversation with staff
- I will not be allowed onto the school premises without a pre-arranged appointment – (please make appointments via telephone or email)
- I will support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time
- I will read all letters/messages and emails. I will regularly check the school website for information
- I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details
- I will follow social distancing rules at all times according to current government guidelines including at the gate entry points
- I will ensure that my child's personal hygiene is of an acceptable standard and that my child is in clean clothing daily.
- If travelling by public transport and using a mask, I will provide a sealed plastic box in which it will be stored when in school
- When bringing a packed lunch it will be in a plastic box cleaned daily
- I will provide named indoor shoes for my child
- If driving to school I will park with respect for others. If walking to school my child will be accompanied by only one adult
- If using the 'Drop & Go' system, I will respect the health and safety of the staff on duty
- I will not drop my child off at the large roundabout as it is illegal to stop on a roundabout

Child

I will do my best to:

- Wash my hands as soon as I enter school
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell
- Not bring things into school from home, eg toys, bikes, scooters etc
- Bring my bookbag daily
- Not mix unnecessarily with any other children in the school that are not in my 'group'
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated area
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue
- Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds
- Follow the rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others
- Bring my own named drinking bottle fill with water
- Bring a named bag with white PE kit to school

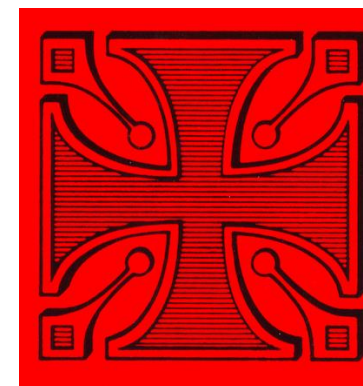
