Today we received a phone call to inform us that St Berteline's will be having an inspection by OFSTED this week (Tuesday and Wednesday).

Inspection tells you about the quality and standards of your child's school. It provides the school with a useful check on its work and can guide us towards further improvement.

An inspection of a school is carried out by inspectors who have been trained by OFSTED. During inspection the inspectors will, amongst other things, talk to children, parents, teachers, watch lessons, look at children's work and generally find out as much as they can about the school and how it works on a day to day basis.

Obviously this is a particularly busy time of the year at St Bert's but nevertheless a time when the school can quite literally 'shine'. We hope that we can all work together in showing our school at its best and would like to ask you to help us in the following ways.

- Please make sure your child has all their necessary equipment in school eg PE kit, pumps, fountain pen, reading book, spelling folders etc.
- Try to get your child into school on time.

- If you need to talk to your child's class teacher, please come into school at the end of the day.
- If your child has a medical appointment, then please send a note into school.
- If your child has been absent then please send a note into school.

This is potentially a very stressful time for teachers (and headteachers!) and we would like to thank you in advance for your support.
