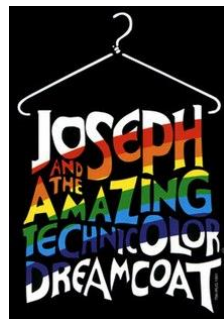
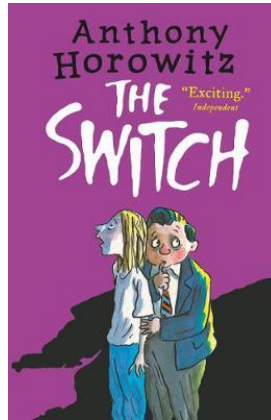


Dear Parents,

This busy half term will see us continue to build our knowledge and understanding in a range of areas across the curriculum.

In maths, the children are looking to continue to build their confidence and fluency with arithmetic. We will be continuing to revise areas of four operations. Children will have revised and learnt lots of skills needed for arithmetic by the end of the term. We will be learning about fractions, decimals and percentages which builds on our skills in arithmetic and reasoning.

In English, we will be building our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills with regular assessments in SPaG and spelling as we continue to learn word classes and spelling patterns taught in KS2. Children will also be developing their writing skills throughout this half term.



We will be continuing to read texts such as The Switch and Fing, in addition to developing our reading response to a range of text types.

We will be learning about Properties of Materials in science: children will be completing a range of written tasks and practical investigations as they develop their understanding of key scientific vocabulary.

In RE, we will be learning about Joseph and his brothers with the theme of regret. This will link to drama and music as we link our learning to Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat.
