


Dear parents and children, This half term we will be covering the following:

- In <u>English</u> we will be focusing on 'A River' by Marc Martin where we will be writing a letter.
 We will be learning about stories and poems as a focus for our comprehension.
 Daily phonics, spelling, punctuation and grammar will take place alongside this.
- Our <u>Maths</u> focus will be Number, Addition and Subtraction, Length & Height (Year 2 will also be looking at Multiplication & Division).
- In <u>Science</u> we will be studying 'Animals, Including Humans'.
- In <u>RE</u> we will study Easter and which part we think is most important in the Easter story.
- In <u>Geography</u> we will look at the weather in the UK.
- In <u>Art</u> we will be exploring Painting and Mixed Media: Life In Colour
- In <u>Heartsmart</u> we will be focusing on 'Don't Hold on to What's Wrong







Your child will also be concentrating on:

- Neat handwriting, presentation and correct use of punctuation.
- PE will take place on Monday's

Items that your child needs to have in school:

- PE Kit: shorts, T-shirt and pumps all named. Warmer P.E clothes (sweatshirt and jogging pants) are needed for outdoor PE.
- Book Bags (not backpacks), Reading Diaries and Reading Books need to be in school every day with reading diaries and reading books inside them. Remember to comment in your child's reading diary once they have read at home (let us know if this is a whole book, a number of pages or a vocabulary hunt etc...) this way your child can change their books at school.
- Water bottles need to be brought into school to keep your child hydrated throughout the day. Please make sure that bottles are filled with water, not juice and are named.
